




Hessian tree ties. Wrap around tree 2.0 times and secure with nails.

Short timber stakes 50mm dia. x 80 -100mm high

Strimmer guard plastic 235x175mm Q31/565B

Tensar 1000 geotextile or similar approved, top of stone drainage layer

Stakes driven into bottom of pit by 200mm




POS - loose mulch to depth 25mm Q31/565A  
Verge - Biodegradable mulch mat firm Q31/567A

Sides of pit to be scarified to remove polish

Drainage of pit to depth 200mm, clean gravel or broken stone, 50mm nominal size Q31/515A


